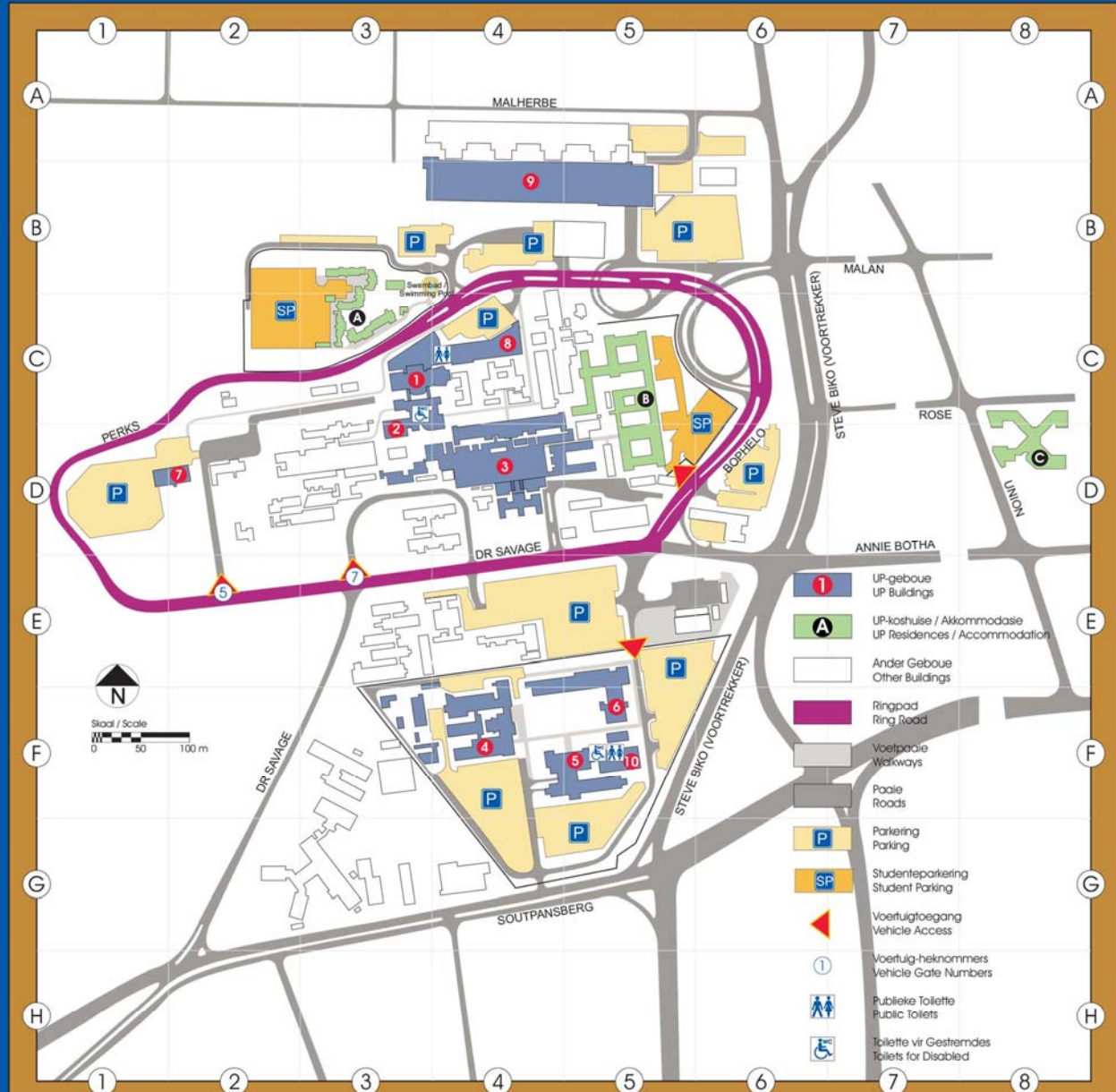

## Narrative Directions to Faculty of Health Sciences, UP

1. **From Johannesburg** take the M1 north, which becomes the N1 north and then continue straight on, which is now the N14. Do not take the Pietersberg N1 loop.
2. Take the Eeufees Road offramp off the N14. At the T Junction turn right and soon after, just after passing under the highway, turn left onto the M7.
3. You are on a short highway with various options. Take the M5, which is the middle option, to Sunnyside.
4. This takes you onto Steve Biko Street, but your maps may show the old names, which change 4 times: Elandspoort, Mears, Jeppe and then Beatrix.
5. Continue on Steve Biko passing a long stretch of shops. A few blocks after the shops end you will pass ABSA. Cross over Soutpansberg Road.
6. At the next intersection, which has a traffic light, turn left into Dr Savage Road and continue past a traffic light and continue to a stop street and straight on.
7. A short distance later, on your right, you will see Entrance 5 to the Western Parking lot of the University.
8. Park here and the security staff will guide you to the HW Snyman Building.

**From OR Tambo International Airport** take the R21 to Pretoria. The R21 becomes named as Nelson Mandela Drive closer to Pretoria. Reach and go around the Fountains Circle following the M5 Sunnyside (and M3 Central Pretoria) and soon after the circle take the left fork of the M5. **GO TO STEP 6**

**From Pretoria**, the options differ according to where you are coming from. If you are not familiar with the area, the best option is to link up with Steve Biko Street and follow the directions from 6 above.
